- Identify and problem solve around gaps in services for new immigrants
- Advocate for services and funding to meet the identified needs
- Be a conduit of information about new immigrants and their needs to other organizations and committees in order that they may better serve this population



OUR MISSION

Agenda/Format of Meetings:

- Discuss a specific need/concern/question related to new immigrants to Cochrane and area
- Presentation
- Everyone (including invited guests) provides input based on what they know about the topic
- Problem solve/determine action plan for addressing the need/concern/question e.g. advocacy, partnership, share the information with another organization/committee, committee initiative
- Invite community stakeholders (i.e Rocky View School staff/administration, Alberta Health Services etc.) to explore how CISC can provide supports/ collaborate to advocate for newcomers
