Each year, AUMA members have the opportunity to submit resolutions on issues of importance to them. These resolutions are then presented, debated, and voted on by our members at the fall Convention. If passed, the resolutions remain active for three years, after which time they expire. On behalf of AUMA's Board, I am pleased to provide information on the outcome of the Town of Olds expired 2014 resolution.

The resolution entitled, "Community Revitalization Levy" called for AUMA to advocate to Municipal Affairs to immediately lift the suspension and allow the Community Revitalization Levy to remain as an option for all municipalities. In addition to our meetings with Ministers, AUMA's submissions on the Municipal Government Act (MGA) included advocacy on the levy. At this time, the Government of Alberta is still reviewing this policy; as a result, AUMA will continue to advocate on this issue.
