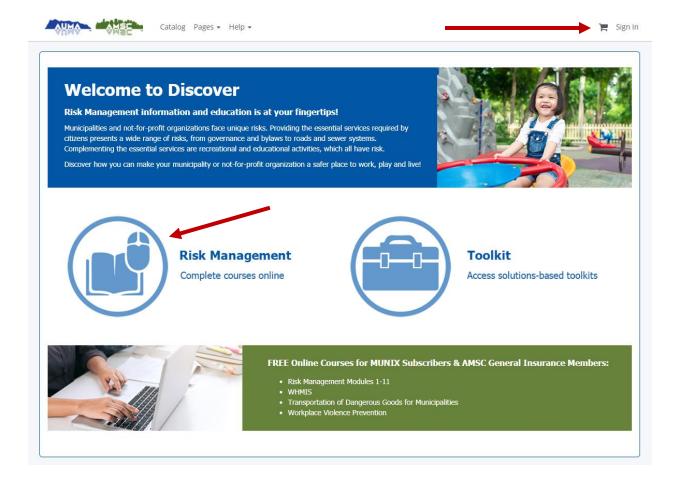
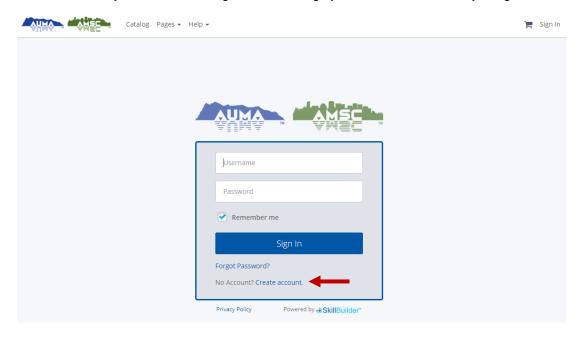


- 1. Go to https://auma.skillbuilder.co/ and sign in

- You can also click on the mouse and book icon next to "Risk Manangemet complete courses online" to access the course catelogue

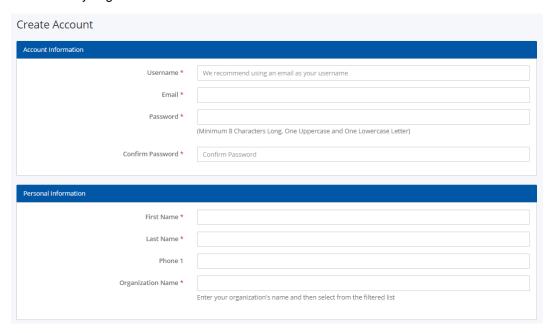




- 2. Using Sign In and Create Account

- If this is your first time using our e-Learning system, there are two ways to get started

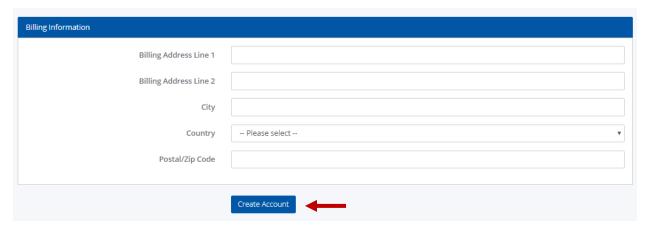


- If this is your first time using our e-Learning website, you will need to click on "Create an Account"
- Fill in as much information as you can and ensure you add your member organization as you are likely eligible for free course content

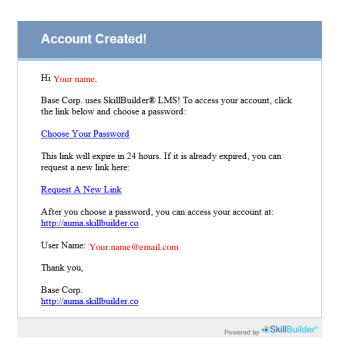




When you have finished filling in all the fields, click on "Create Account"

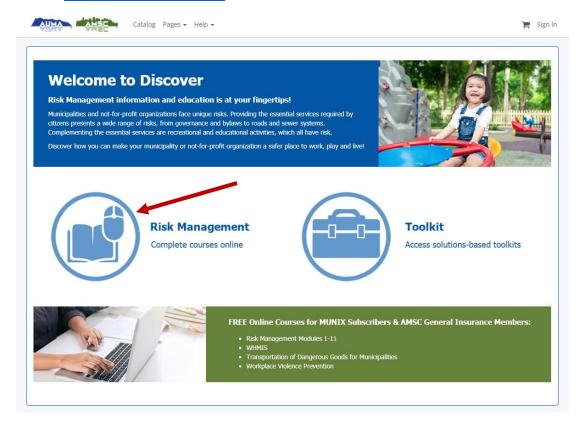


- If it is your first time signing in and you were added in by an administrator, you will receive an email addressed to you
- Use the "Choose Your Password" link to create your personal and private password

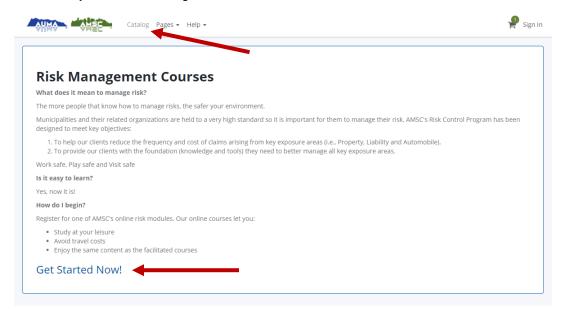




3. Clicking on the mouse and book icon next to "Risk Manangemet complete courses online" on https://auma.skillbuilder.co/

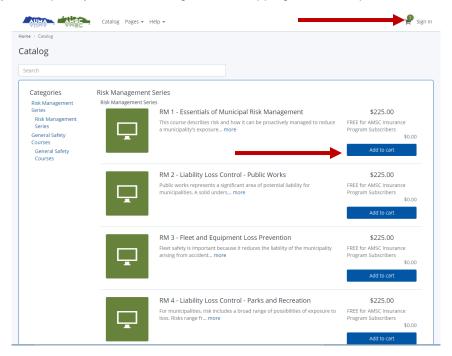


It will take you to page where you can access our e-Learning offerings and shopping cart two
ways via the "Catalog" or "Get Started Now!" links



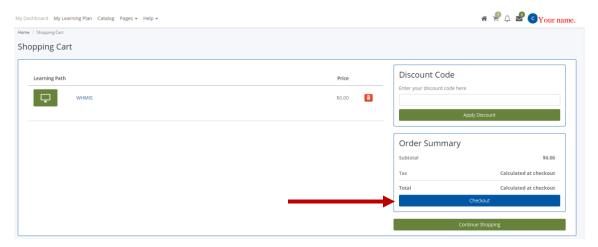


- You will find to our current e-Learning offerings

- When you complete your selections, go to the shopping cart to complete the transaction

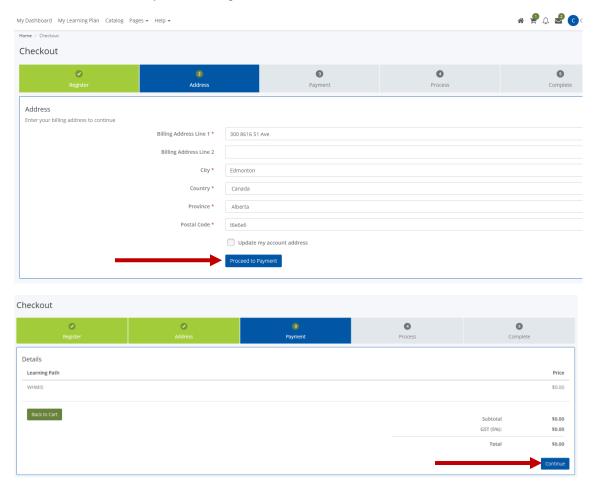




- 4. Complete your transaction
- At the checkout, AMSC members will have a \$0 total, but you still do need to complete the transaction by clicking on "Checkout"

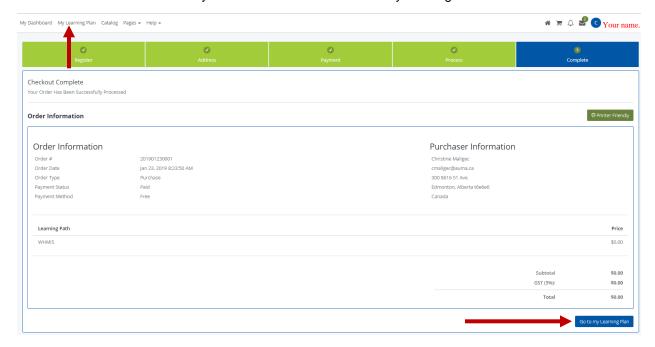


• Confirm or enter in your address and click on "Proceed to Payment" and then "Continue" to add the modules to your Learning Path
