The competitive edge for your municipal hiring.

MuniSERP is a powerful attraction and retention tool for municipalities to retain senior managers.

It is a supplemental employee retirement plan (SERP) designed for senior management which provides additional non-registered retirement benefits beyond what is allowable under the LAPP and APEX supplementary pension plan.



Designed for you.

Once participating in the MuniSERP program, the employer becomes the program sponsor.

As program sponsor you determine:

- which of your senior management employees is eligible to participate
- under which circumstances a benefit would be payable
- whether a benefit payable would be made as a lump sum payout or by fixed instalment payments
- whether a benefit payable maximum applies

As program sponsor, you are also responsible to indicate through employment agreements and/or policies that:

- MuniSERP benefits are solely available to the employee from the employer
- any benefits payable to the employee are based on the employee agreement and/or policies with the employer and that neither the plan administrator or any related party has any obligation to the employee

How it works

Benefits and funding

■ MuniSERP benefits are 100% employer paid, based on an annual actuarial costing report. Benefits are taxable to the employee only upon receiving a benefit payout.

Plan administration

■ The Alberta Municipalities
Retirement Services team works
with employers to implement the
program and to provide ongoing
support. The Alberta Municipal
Services Corporation (AMSC) is
responsible for administration
of the MuniSERP Program. The
APEX Governance Board provides
governance and administrative
oversight of all plans.
